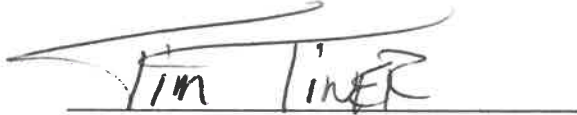
With all five (5) members voting AYE, the Motion Carried.
